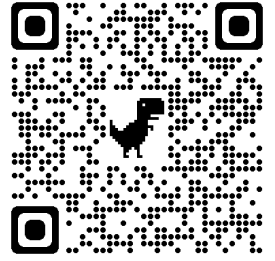
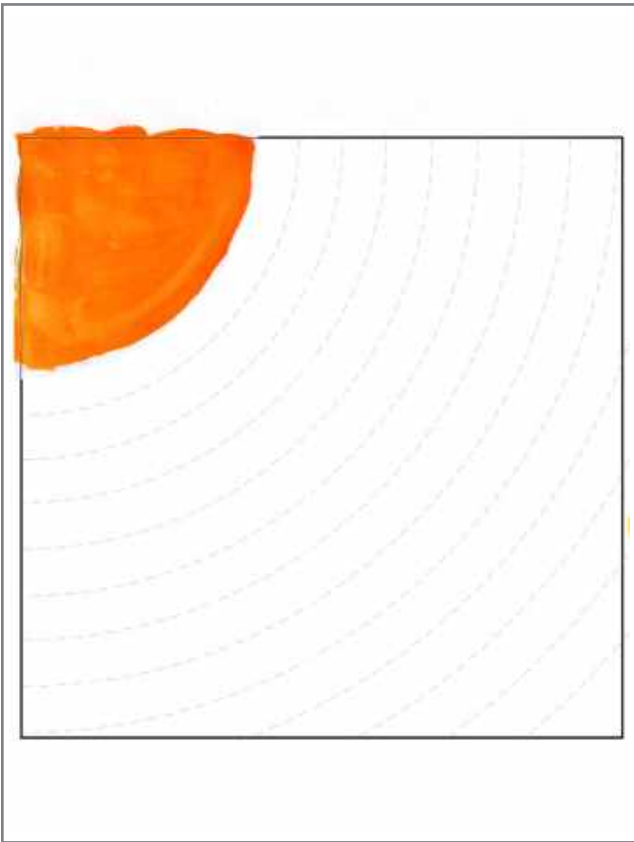


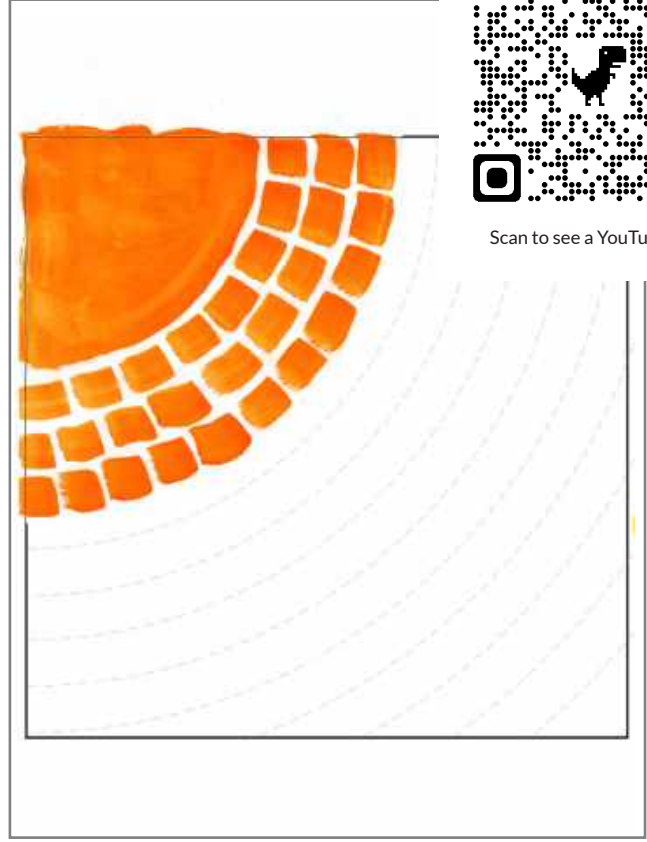
Paint Alma Woodsey Thomas Circles



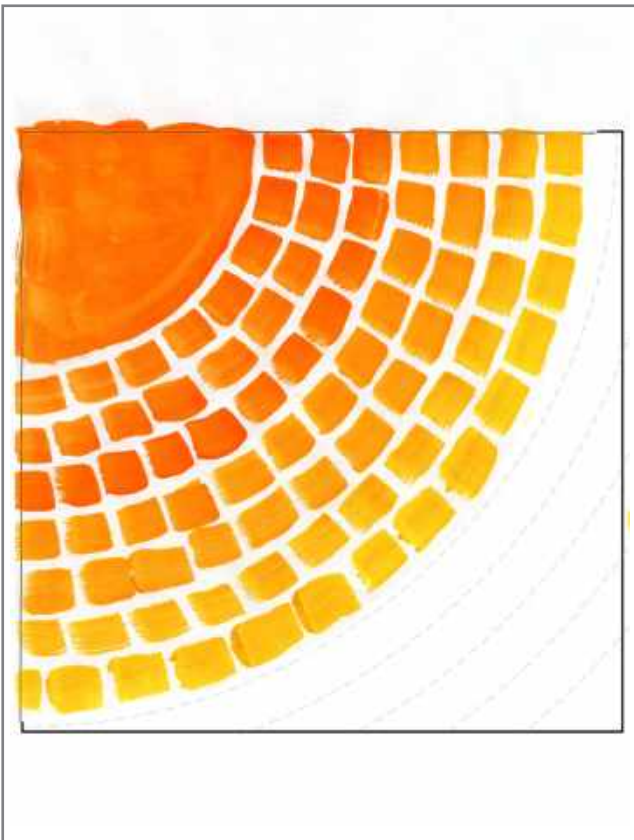

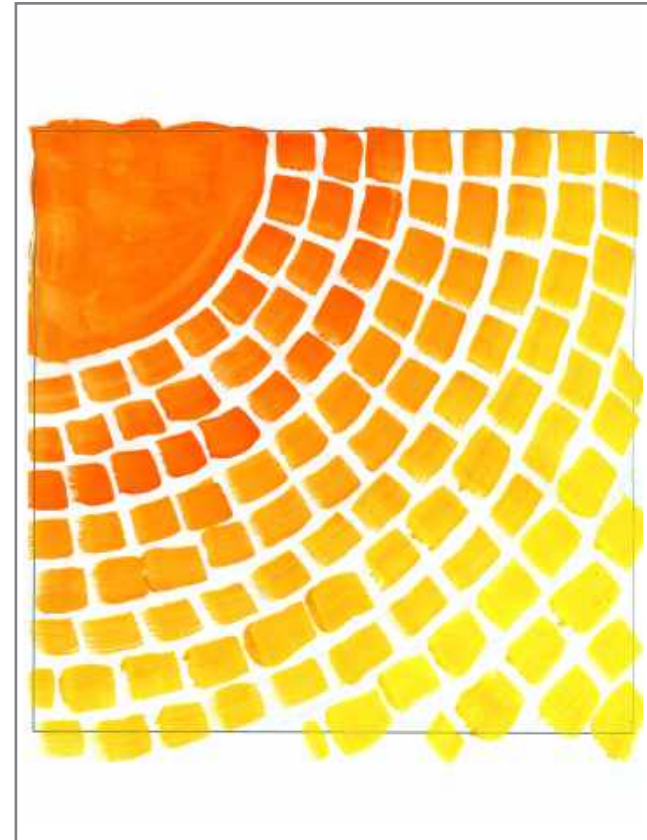
1. Choose two colors of paint. This example uses orange and yellow. Fill the quarter circle with one of the colors.



2. Then add about three rows of dashed lines with that same color. The dashes can sit in between the lines, or ON them, either is fine.

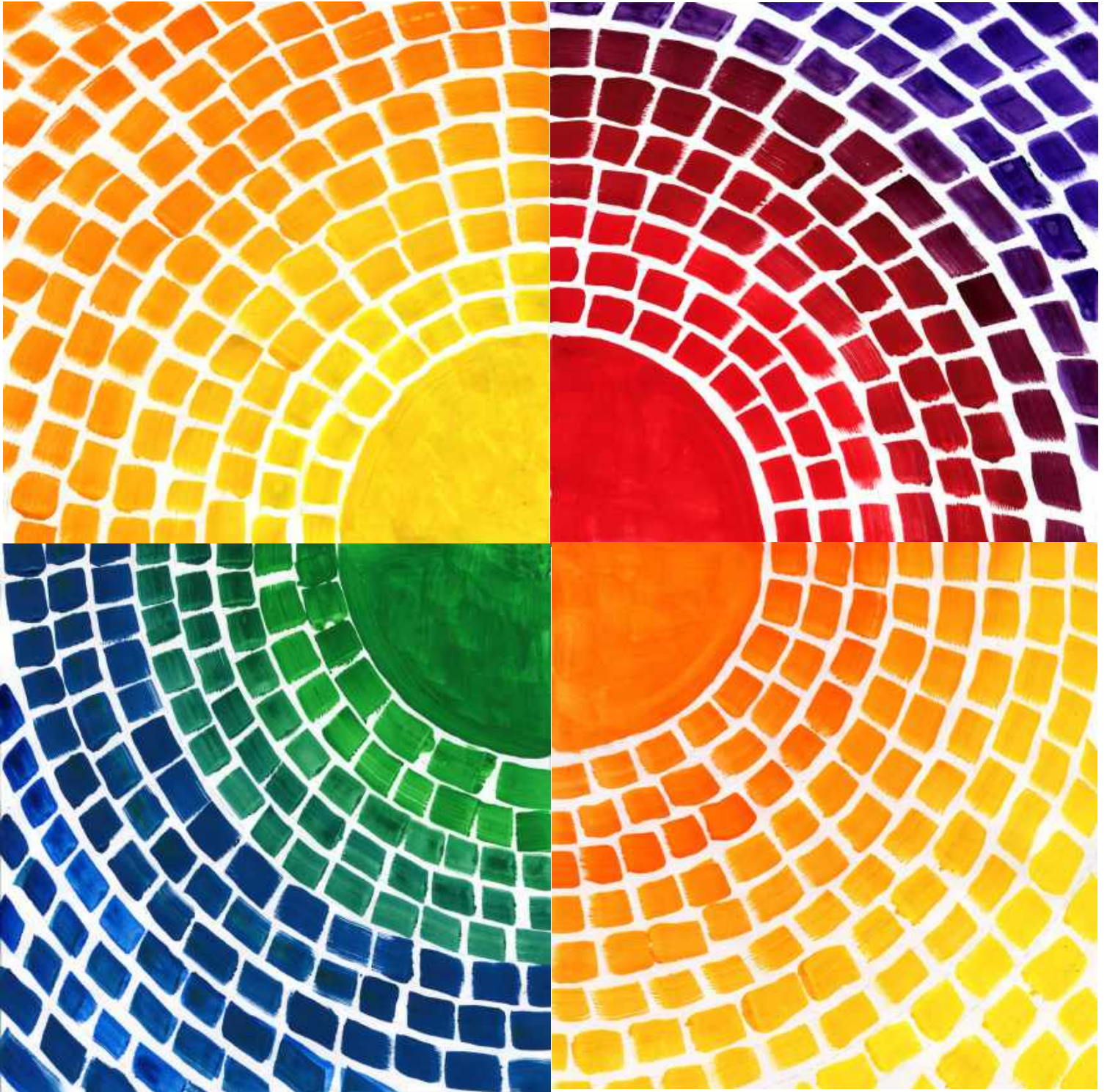


3. Mix in more of the second color as you paint more rows of lines. The goal is to make a gradual change to the second color.

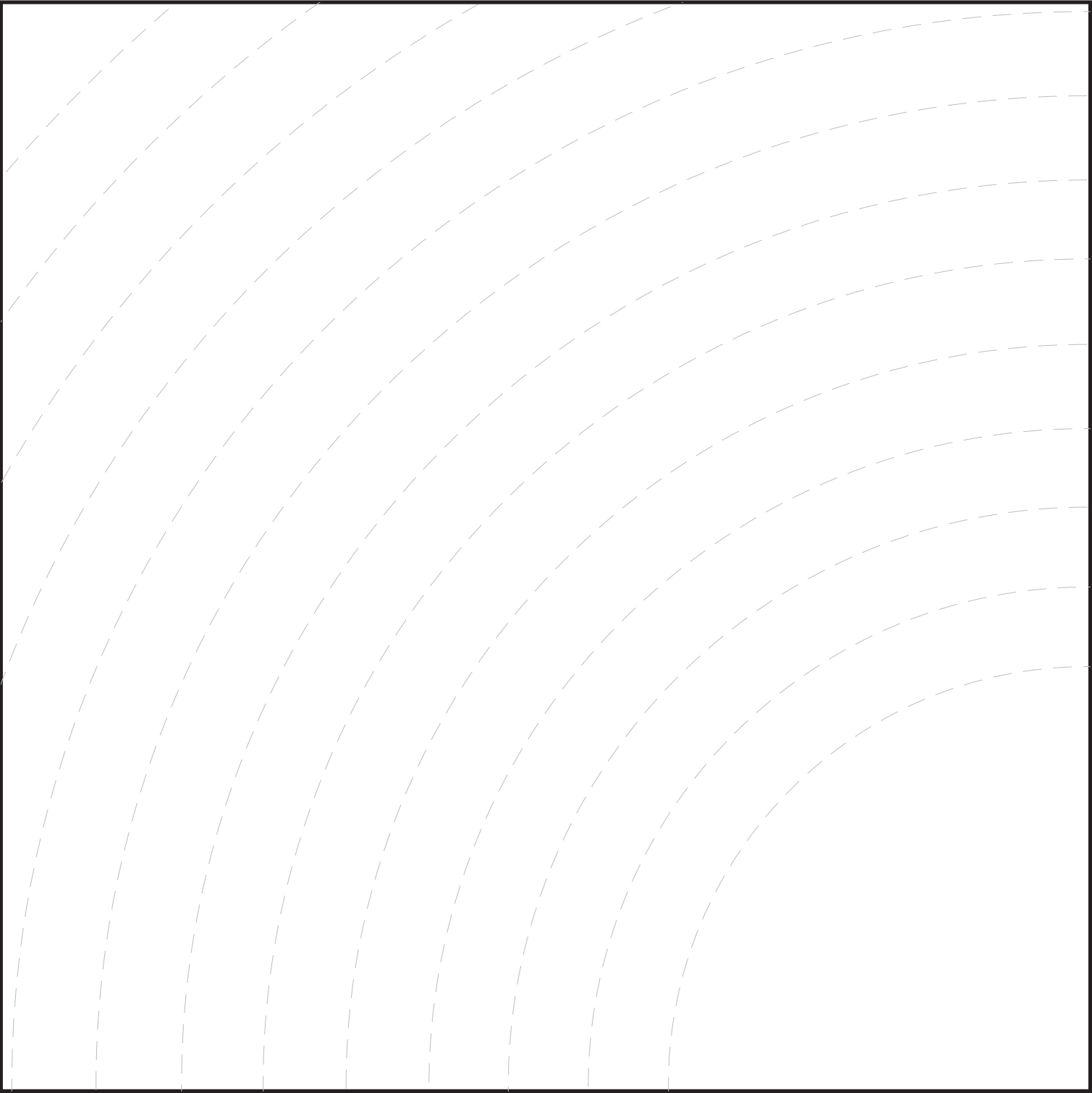


4. When nearing the last few rows, clean the brush and paint with ONLY the second color to get a full gradation. Let dry and trim to the lines.
